Roger Lonneville, Commissioner called the meeting to order at 6:35 PM

Commissioner Lonneville explained the special meeting was called to discuss the letter from Kent Masecar which states that he refuses to do the Monthly DMR Reports, Yearly Compost Report, E.P.A. Study Test. The letter states he is back to Laborer and wants extra compensation to do the testing. See attached letter.

Commissioner Lonneville called DEC was informed we are in violation, the DMR report for December has not been sent in as of this date. Which Kent Masecar was to sign and send in. It was explained to DEC the situation at the Plant at this time. Commissioner Lonneville was informed that to fulfill DEC requirements there has to be an employee with a 3-A license and be at the Plant for at least 20 hours a week, this should take place immediately. Commissioner Lonneville will follow up on acquiring an employee with the DEC qualifications.

Trustee Bogner will sign the December reports and get them sent in. Commissioner Lonneville and Trustee Bogner will check to see if January reports are done. They will visit the plant, but would like to wait to hear from Civil Service; Mayor Mink would like to have a call from John Garvey (Civil Service) before proceeding with this situation.

The letter from Kent Masecar was sent over to Civil Service to John Garvey. We are waiting for a response from him in order to proceed. Also Attorney John Tyo has been given the paperwork also.

Trustee Sharon Trimm wants it to be known in her opinion Kent Masecar's letter is displaying insubordination and feels he should be suspended with pay from the plant until this is resolved.

Mayor Mink motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Trustee Bogner, voted and carried unanimously at 7:50PM
